PhD and MD-PhD students from the Herbert Wertheim School of Public Health, Scripps Institution of Oceanography, Jacobs School of Engineering, School of Biological Sciences, School of Medicine, School of Physical Sciences, and Skaggs School of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences are particularly encouraged to apply, though the fellowship is open to all disciplines. Applications should include: (1) a CV; (2) a research proposal (no longer than 3 pages); and (3) a letter of nomination from the applicant's PI/faculty advisor indicating their support for the applicant's participation in this program. Applicants may also include an optional letter of support from their proposed host research mentor. Please submit applications via the Merkin Graduate Fellows Program Application Form.

Faculty may also nominate prospective applicants they believe would be a good fit for the program by submitting a <u>nomination form</u>. Nominees will be contacted by the Merkin Fellowship Program Manager to encourage them to apply.

Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis once per quarter, with the Winter quarter review date on **January 20, 2023**.
